Main Responsibilities

- Operate, test, test-run, troubleshoot, maintain, calibrate, or repair automated, servo-mechanical, or electromechanical equipment
- Start-up production lines/utilities and monitor activities
- Abide by health and safety rules and guidelines
- Troubleshoot controls/PLC system for automated production lines following blueprints, schematic drawing and other specifications
- Perform preventative maintenance procedures, identify problems, assess the root causes and recommend opportunities for improvement
- Perform daily, weekly, and monthly PM schedules & Keep up-to-date documentation for all maintenance actions
- Repair and replace components, such as pneumatics, bearings, conveyors, motors, electric relays
- Record all types of malfunction and repair work performed in the Maintenance system

- Respond to alerts and operation messages – carry out corrective procedures and repairs in line with SOPs and maintenance protocols
- Assist in projects such as installation of new manufacturing equipment and perform additional tasks, as needed
